


2. Description of the discipline

Short annotation of the course, relevance.

The discipline «Sociology and Medical Sociology» is aimed at forming the foundations of «sociological imagination» in future physicians, lays the foundations of knowledge in medicine and health care as a social institution. Studies the relationship between health and social aspects of human life, considers the use of special sociological theories and methods for multifaceted analysis of the origin, course and prevention of various diseases.

Studying the course is important for a number of reasons:

- the need for the formation of integrated ideas about society and understanding of their own social context;
- understanding the health care system as an element of a holistic social system, the place and status of physicians as a separate social group in society;
- the importance of skills of sociological research, methods of conflict prevention and resolution in the performance of professional duties of a doctor;
- Awareness of the doctor of the social preconditions for the occurrence of diseases, as well as the social context of treatment of various types of health disorders.

Prerequisites. For successful mastering of discipline, the student needs the knowledge received in the course of studying of the following general disciplines:

For successful mastering of the discipline students need knowledge gained in the process of studying the following disciplines of general training in secondary school: «Man and the World», «Civic Education», «Fundamentals of Law», «Fundamentals of Health».

The purpose of the course and its significance for professional activities is to master students' skills of sociological analysis of society, determining their place and role in it, forming an understanding of the functioning and development of medicine and health care as a social institution, the relationship of health and social aspects of life people, the application of sociological knowledge in life and medical practice.

Postrequisites. In the process of studying the discipline, a student acquires knowledge, which is necessary for successful mastering of professional training disciplines, namely: «History of Ukraine and Ukrainian culture», «History of world culture», «Fundamentals of economic theory», «Economics

of health care. Marketing of medical services», «Philosophy», «Logic. Formal logic». «Aesthetics and Theory of Art», «Ethics and deontology in medicine», «Methods and Technology of the Student's Scientific Work Preparation», «Academic Decency», «Fundamentals of psychology», «Medical psychology», «History of Medicine», «Social medicine, public health», «Principles of forming a healthy lifestyle», «Life safety, basics of bioethics and biosafet», «Civil Defense», «Hygiene and Ecology», «Efficient communication as indicator of productive interaction between doctors and patients», «Forensic medicine and medical law of Ukraine» which involves the integration of teaching with these disciplines and the application of acquired knowledge, skills and abilities in the process of further education and professional activities.

3. Learning outcomes.

After successful study of the discipline the applicant will be able to:

- to analyze the patterns of formation of the social structure of society, scientific approaches to the problem of society development;
- understand the essence of the process of socialization, acquisition of social status and role;
- explain the causes of conflict and ways to overcome them;
- to determine the main directions of research in medical sociology and methods of their conduct;
- to determine the place of physicians as a social group in the social structure of society;
- take into account in professional activities the social status of the patient, his social roles as a means of influencing the patient for his effective treatment;
- determine the role of social and socio-psychological factors in the spread of disease;
- use knowledge of resocialization and lifelong socialization when working with critically ill and injured patients;
- apply the acquired knowledge of sociology of medicine and sociology of health care to establish appropriate relationships with patients and colleagues.

4. Content and logistic of the discipline

The course includes 10 topics, which are divided into 1 thematic modul.

- Topic 1. Sociology as a science about society
- Topic 2. The methods of sociological researches
- Topic 3. Historical development of sociology
- Topic 4. Social structure of a society
- Topic 5. Social stratification
- Topic 6. Sociological concept of a person. Socialization
- Topic 7. Social behavior.
- Topic 8. Sociology of the conflict
- Topic 9. Sociology of medicine. Social conditions of diseases
- Topic 10. Sociology of a family

The lecture course discovers the problematic issues of the relevant sections of sociology

Practical classes provide a theoretical justification of the main issues of the topic and the acquisition of the following practical skills:

1. navigate in different directions, trends and schools of sociological science, connect theoretical ideas and concepts with the practice of society, professional activities in the field of medicine and health care, modern problems of society;
2. be able to objectively, on a scientific basis to assess the state and development of society, to apply the acquired knowledge in everyday life and professional practice;
3. anticipate the prospect of implementing theoretical statements of medical sociology in combination with medical disciplines;
4. choose methods of conflict prevention and resolution;
5. to apply in practice knowledge of the social structure of society and social movements in planning their own careers;
6. take into account the interests of certain communities in making management decisions
7. independently analyze the data of sociological research, operate with methods of sociological research in practice in combination with professional knowledge;

In practical classes, students report, discuss, reasonably defend their views and positions, formulate conclusions on the topic and solve tests.

The student's independent work involves preparation for practical classes, studying topics for independent extracurricular activities, preparation of presentations, tables, albums, posters, elaboration of scientific literature and writing reviews on the provided topics. Control of mastering the topics of independent extracurricular work is carried out in the classroom and the final control of the discipline.

Thematic plans of lectures, calendar plans of practical classes, thematic plan of independent extracurricular work, volume and directions of individual work are published on the site of the department.

7. Policy of discipline / course

The student has the right to receive high-quality educational services, access to contemporary scientific and educational information, qualified tutoring during the study of discipline and mastering practical skills. The policy of the department during the providing of educational services is a student-centered, based on normative documents of the Ministry of Education and the Ministry of Health of Ukraine, the Statute of the University and the Procedure for the Providing of Educational Services regulated by the main principles of the organization of the educational process in National Pirogov Memorial Medical University, Vinnytsya and the principles of academic integrity (link <https://www.vnmu.edu.ua/en/general-information>)

Adherence to the rules of National Pirogov Memorial Medical University, Vinnytsya, safety techniques in practical classes.

Instruction on safety and behavior during the signal «Air alarm!» is conducted at the first practical lesson by the teacher. The instructed students are registered in the Safety Instruction Journal.

Requirements for preparation for practical classes.

The student should be prepared for a practical lesson, testing tasks for the current topic should be solved in a workbook, diagrams and tables are filled.

A student should come to class on time, without delay. A student who is more than 15 minutes late is not allowed to the practical class and must work it in the prescribed manner.

The student must follow the rules of safety in practical rooms and at the department.

When discussing theoretical issues, students should demonstrate tolerance, courtesy and respect for their colleagues and the teacher; when performing practical tasks, the workplace should be kept in order and be cleaned after performing practical work.

Usage of mobile phones and other electronic devices.

The use of mobile phones and other electronic devices in the classroom is allowed only during electronic testing or surveys and performing search and group tasks.

Academic integrity. When studying the discipline, the student must be guided by the Code of Academic Integrity and Corporate Ethics of National Pirogov Memorial Medical University, Vinnytsya (link : <https://www.vnmu.edu.ua/en/general-information/> Code of Academic Integrity). In case of violation of the norms of academic integrity during the current and final controls student receives a grade of "2" and must work it out to his teacher in the prescribed manner within two weeks after receiving an unsatisfactory assessment).

Missed classes. Missed classes are working out in the manner prescribed by Regulations of the Academic process in National Pirogov Memorial Medical University, Vinnytsya (link <https://www.vnmu.edu.ua/en/general-information/>) at the time of work out schedule (published on the website of the department <https://www.vnmu.edu.ua/> Philosophy and Social Sciences Department #) to the teacher of the group or duty teacher.

The procedure for admission to the discipline final control is given in the Regulation of the Academic process in National Pirogov Memorial Medical University, Vinnytsya (link <https://www.vnmu.edu.ua/en/general-information/>). Students who do not have missed practical classes and received an average traditional grade of at least «3» are allowed to final control.

Additional points. Individual points in the discipline that student can receive for individual work, is determined by the results of his individual work according to Regulation of the Academic process in National Pirogov Memorial Medical University, Vinnytsya (link <https://www.vnmu.edu.ua/en/general-information/>) and policy of the course.

Conflict resolution. In case of misunderstandings and complaints to the teacher because of the quality of educational services, knowledge assessment and other conflict situations, student should submit his / her claims to the teacher. If the issue is not resolved, the student has a right to apply to the head of the department according to Complaints Consideration Procedure (<https://www.vnmu.edu.ua/> General information / Basic documents).

Politics in terms of remote learning.
